



# Iowa Soccer Club Fee Structure 2011-2012

The Iowa Soccer Club has two main types of fees, **club fees** and **team fees**. Club fees are applied to all club players and are paid to the ISC. Team fees are unique to each individual team and are paid to your team treasurer.

## CLUB FEES

### (Year Round Advanced Players and POP Players)

#### 1. Registration Fee

U9-U18 Year Round and POP players = \$100

Payment in full is due after you accept a roster position. You will pay this at the "post tryout registration" site. If you join after August 1, then the payment is due on the date that you join. We do not pro-rate this fee if you join after August 1, 2011.

**Fee Explanation:** The ISC collects an annual registration fee from every player in the club. This fee is necessary to cover the expenses the club incurs when registering your child with the state and national soccer associations. The registration fee also covers the extensive overhead costs necessary to run our soccer club. These costs include the expenses incurred from the following sources: office and administrative expenses, including phone, fax, postage, advertising, liability insurance, and internet services, and other overhead expenses necessary to maintain the organization.

#### 2. Coaching and Administrative Staff Fee

U9-U10 Year Round and POP players = \$45/mo (\$540/yr)

U11-U18 Year Round and POP players = \$50/mo (\$600/yr)

Payment in full or monthly auto withdrawal authorization form is due after you reserve a roster position; or if joining the club after August 1, then the payment is due on the date that you join. Please see auto withdrawal explanation letter for more information on this payment option. Scholarships are available for those with financial need.

**Fee Explanation:** The coaching and administrative staff fee will cover the cost of the professional coaching and administrative staff. This fee will cover 65 (U9-U14 sessions), or 80 (U15-U18) training sessions with the ISC professional staff, coaching from the ISC staff for 75 % of all games all year, and cover goalie training for the team's goalies. In addition, these fees cover the expense for our administrative staff.

#### 3. Facility Fee

U9-U14 Year Round and POP players = \$280/yr

U15-U18 Year Round and POP players = \$310/yr

Payment in full is due October 1 or on the date that you join the club if you join after October 1.

**Fee Explanation:** The ISC collects an annual facility fee from every player in the club. All revenue collected for facility fees are allocated to cover the expenses related to renting outdoor and indoor practice fields in order to reserve field space for your team's practices per year. Furthermore, the facility fees are also allocated to pay for optional practices and programs that are special to the ISC. These programs include the Incentive Plan, Open Plays, Super Skills, and the March Madness Event.

## Lightning Fees - 6-8 years old

Fall: \$160 August - December (1 session/week)

Spring: \$220 January - June (1 session/week)

Fall Lightning Fees are due at time of registration. The Lightning fee covers all expenses listed above.

## TEAM FEES

### (Year Round Advanced Players Only)

To be sent to your team treasurer

Team fees are unique to each team and set by your team manager and/or treasurer. Team fees are paid in two installments, one for the Fall season and one for the Spring/Summer season. Team fees cover the following costs.

1. Tournament Entry Fees (only for tournaments recommended by ISC Coaching Staff)

2. League Fees (only fall and spring league fees)

3. Coaching Reimbursement Expense (for travel tournaments only—see explanation below)

**Fee Explanation:** At the beginning of each outdoor soccer season each ISC team will need to submit payment for league fees and tournament fees. Each full ISC team maintains their own checking account, which is managed by a volunteer team treasurer. The team treasurer will be responsible to submit payment to the league and tournaments in order to ensure that their team will be accepted for the league or tournament.

Travel tournaments includes all cities traveled to except: Muscatine, Dubuque, Burlington, Cedar Rapids, Cedar Falls, Marshalltown, and the Quad Cities. Coaches are not paid a per diem to coach in the cities listed above. Outside of this local area, coaches are paid \$60.00 per day at tournaments in order to cover their food and gas expenses for coaching in areas outside of the boundaries listed above. If a coach travels on a weekday to the tournament they are paid \$30.00 for the "travel day" to cover travel expenses. For U9-U18 players, even if you do not go to a tournament you must pay that tournament's fee.

Coaches are NOT reimbursed for travel to IPSL, ICCR, or Sportszone League Games.

Please note that the amount that each family will be responsible to pay for team fees will differ from team to team. The more tournaments and travel tournaments each team attends, the greater the fee. Please remember team fees are paid to your team treasurer. Team fees are not paid to the ISC office.
