



# Iowa Soccer Club

## Fee Structure

### 2008-2009

The Iowa Soccer Club has two main types of fees, club fees and team fees. Club fees are applied to all club players and are paid to the ISC office. Team fees are unique to each individual team and are paid to your team treasurer. Below is an explanation of each type of fee.

#### CLUB FEES

##### **1. Registration Fee**

U8-U18 players = \$75

Payment in full is due 7 days after you reserve a roster position (either June 23 or July 3); or if joining the club after August 1, then the payment is due on the date that you join

**Fee Explanation:** The ISC collects an annual registration fee from every player in the club. This fee is necessary to cover the expenses the club incurs when registering your child with the state and national soccer associations. The registration fee also covers the extensive overhead costs necessary to run our soccer club. Your registration fee helps cover the expenses incurred from the following sources: accounting services, office and administrative expenses, including phone, fax, postage, advertising, liability insurance, and internet services, and other overhead expenses necessary to maintain the organization.

##### **2. Coaching Fee**

U8 players = \$25/mo (\$300/yr)

U9-U12 players = \$40/mo (\$480/yr)

U13-U15 players = \$42/mo (\$504/yr)

U16-U18 players = \$45/mo (\$540/yr)

Payment in full or monthly autowithdrawal authorization form is due 7 days after you reserve a roster position (either June 23 or July 3); or if joining the club after August 1, then the payment is due on the date that you join. Please see autowithdrawal explanation letter for more information on this payment option. Scholarships are available.

**Fee Explanation:** The coaching fee will cover the cost of the professional coaching and administrative staff. This cost will cover 30 (U8), 65 (U9-U15), or 80 (U16-U18) training session with the ISC professional staff, coaching from the ISC staff for at least half of all games played per season, and the fees cover goalie training for the team's goalies.

##### **3. Facility Fee**

U8 players = \$80/yr

U9-U15 players = \$250/yr

U16-U18 players = \$280/yr

Payment in full is due October 1 or on the date that you join the club.

**Fee Explanation:** The ISC collects an annual facility fee from every player in the club. All monies collected for facility fees are allocated to cover the expenses related to renting outdoor and indoor practice fields in order to reserve field space for your team's practices per year. Furthermore, the facility fees are also allocated to pay for free practices and programs that are special to the ISC. These programs include the Incentive Plan, Open Plays, Super Skills, and the March Madness Event. No additional coaching fees for these programs will be assessed as long as the facility income collected in October is sufficient enough to allow for the scheduling of these programs.

#### TEAM FEES

To be sent to your team treasurer

Team fees are unique to each team and set by your team manager and/or treasurer. Team fees are paid in two installments, one for the Fall season and one for the Spring/Summer season. Team fees cover the following costs.

1. Tournament Entry Fees (only for tournaments recommended by ISC Coaching Staff)

2. League Fees (only fall and spring league fees)

3. Coaching Expenses (for travel tournaments only—see explanation below)

4. Parent Coach ISA Registration Fee

5. Team Copies, Faxes, and Stamps for Team Mailings. These are expenses incurred by your own team manager or treasurer, not by the ISC staff.

**Fee Explanation:** At the beginning of each outdoor soccer season each ISC team will need to submit payment for league fees and tournament fees. Each full ISC team maintains their own checking account, which is managed by a team treasurer. The team treasurer will be responsible to submit payment to the league and tournaments in order to ensure that their team will be accepted for the league or tournament.

Travel tournaments includes all cities traveled to except: Muscatine, Dubuque, Burlington, Cedar Rapids, Cedar Falls, Marshalltown, and the Quad Cities. Coaches are not paid a per diem to coach in the cities listed above. Coaches are paid \$60.00 per day at tournaments in order to cover their food and gas expenses for coaching in areas outside of the boundaries listed above. If a coach travels on a weekday to the tournament they are paid \$30.00 for the "travel day" to cover travel expenses. For U9-U15 players, even if you do not go to a tournament you must pay that tournament's fee. For U16-U18 players, you only pay for the tournaments that you attend.

Indoor league fees are not covered by team fees. Only those who choose to play indoor games are charged to play. Each team's parent manager will inform you of the amount due if you choose to play in the winter Sportszone league. The ISC Director of Coaching expects all full ISC teams to register in at least one indoor session. Some individuals on your team may not play in the indoor session.

Please note that the amount that each family will be responsible to pay for team fees will differ from team to team. The more tournaments and travel tournaments each team attends, the greater the fee. Please remember team fees are paid to your team treasurer.
