



Iowa Soccer Club Fee Structure 2017-2018

The Iowa Soccer Club has two main types of fees, club fees and team fees. Club fees are applied to all year round players and are paid to the ISC. Team fees are unique to each individual team and are paid to your team treasurer.

Total Annual ISC Club Fees for Advanced Year Round, "POP" & "POPPI"

9U-19U: \$1,165 Per Player

2017-2018 ISC Club Fees by Category

All Fees below apply to Advanced Year Round, "POP", and ALL "POPPI" players

1. Registration Fee

9U-19U: \$175 per year

The registration fee of \$175 must be paid in full at the time of post clinic and tryout registration. This annual fee MUST be paid via credit card or debit card during online registration after the clinics and trout notifications have been emailed out to the players. This fee is not prorated if joining mid-season.

Fee Explanation:

The ISC collects an annual registration fee from every player in the club. This fee is necessary to cover the expenses the club incurs when registering your child with the state and national soccer associations. The registration fee also covers the extensive overhead costs necessary to run our soccer club. These costs include the expenses incurred from the following sources: office and administrative expenses, including phone, fax, postage, advertising, liability insurance, and internet services, coach per diem and hotel travel, and other overhead expenses necessary to maintain the organization.

2. Coaching and Administrative Staff Fee

9U-19U: \$660 per year

The coaching/admin fee can be paid in full at the time of post clinic and tryout registration via check. This fee cannot be paid online via credit or debit card. If you do not want to pay this fee in full at the time of post tryout and clinic registration, you can set up automatic withdrawal of the fees from your bank account. The funds are withdrawn from your account on the 1st day of each month.

Fee Explanation:

The coaching and administrative staff fee will cover the cost of the professional coaching and administrative staff. This fee will cover 70 (9U-14U) training sessions or 80 (15U-19U) training sessions with the ISC professional staff, coaching from the ISC staff for 95% of all games all year, and goalie training. In addition, these fees cover the expense for our administrative staff, including salaries for ISC administrators.

3. Facility Fee:

9U-19U: \$330 per player

The facility fee can be paid in full at the time of post clinic and tryout registration via check. This fee cannot be paid online via credit or debit card. If you do not want to pay the fee in full at the time of post tryout and clinic registration, you can set up automatic withdrawal of the fees from your bank account. The funds are withdrawn from your account on the 1st day of each month.

Fee explanation:

The ISC collects an annual facility fee from every player in the club. All revenue collected for facility fees is allocated to cover the expenses related to renting outdoor and indoor practice fields in order to reserve field space for your team's practices each year. Furthermore, the facility fees are also allocated to pay for optional practices and programs that are special to the ISC.

TEAM FEES

Team Fees only apply to players on the Advanced Year Round Teams. Players in the "POPPI" and the "POP" program do not pay any team fees. Players in the "POPPI" program will pay indoor league fees as described at the bottom of this page.

Team fees are paid to your team treasurer. **These fees are not paid to the ISC office.**

Team fees are unique to each team and set by your team manager and/or treasurer. Team fees are paid in three installments, one for the fall season, one for winter tournaments, and one for the spring/summer season. Team fees cover the following costs.

1. Tournament Entry Fees (only for tournaments recommended by ISC Coaching Staff)
2. League Fees (fall and spring league fees)

At the beginning of each soccer season each ISC team will need to submit payment for league fees and tournament fees. Each full ISC team maintains their own checking account, which is managed by a volunteer team treasurer. The team treasurer will be responsible to submit payment to the league and tournaments in order to ensure that their team will be accepted for the league or tournament.

Please note that the amount that each family will be responsible to pay for team fees will differ from team to team. The more tournaments and travel tournaments each team attends, the greater the fee. Please remember team fees are paid to your team treasurer. Team fees are not paid to the ISC office. If team fees are not paid, the player card is held.

Uniform Fees

Each member pays for their uniforms on their own by ordering online for their uniform needs. Therefore, the uniform fee is separate from the two fee categories listed on this page. The link to purchase the required items is listed on the ISC homepage at www.iowasoccerclub.com The average cost for the full uniform kit is \$100.

ISC Winter League Fees

For all ISC players, the ISC offers winter leagues that we run and manage. In order to participate in these leagues, a separate fee is assessed. The fee to play in these leagues is not included in your other club fees. More info about the fees for these leagues is available on the ISC website. ISC players are required to play in the leagues.
